Rules for Tarbiya: Imaan

1. Raise their Imaan

- Teach the Kalima
- Stories of prophets, Sahab and Salaf
- Make them listen Quran
- Nasheed

2. Teach them to Love Allah and the Prophet Muhammad ﷺ

- Turn him to Allah each and every time
- Loving through his creations
- Teach him Sunnah ways



Rules for Tarbiya

3. Make them habitual for mandatory Worships:

- Start from Namaz
- Pray nafl at your home
- Remember Allah in your home
- Reward him on it



Rules for Tarbiya: Moral

- Common bad habits in children:
 - Lying
 - Theft
 - Swearing
 - Greedy
 - Moral evils , watching obscene content etc



Rules for Tarbiya: Moral

4. Tarbiya

- Honesty. Not lying
- Caring for the less-privileged
- Using soft words not swear words
- Saying jazakallah
- Showing respect to: elders, brothers, neighbors, servants, relatives



5. Love

By your action not words...



Children are like MONKEYS. They imitate your actions not your words!!



Rules for Tarbiya: Moral

5. Love and Rahmah

- Hugging, kissing, smelling (Sunnah)
- Tell him How much Allah loves us
- Loving animals
- Love stories
- Loving others in his presence



Rules for Tarbiya: Moral

6. Haya and modesty

- Do not wear exposing clothes
- Teach him to cover his satr
- Teach him to lower his gaze
- Make them proud of Islamic culture and ways
- Distance them from western and hindu cultural ways.



Rules for Tarbiya: Moral

7. Brave and self confident

- Do not tell horror fiction stories
- Praise and reward on act of bravery
- Tell him: My Son is BRAVE
- Stories of Battles of the prophet and sahaba
- Push him into difficult tasks as per his age
- Motivate him to accept challenges
- Teach him to deal with failures
- Give him company of brave boys
- Give pocket money to spend independently
- **Be a superhero for him**

7. Brave and self confident Habits to be disposed off:

- Shy and clumsy
- Fear
- Inferiority complex احساس کمتری
- Hasad
- Seeking refuge everytime



Rules for Tarbiya: Moral

8. Generosity سخاوت

- Make him Donate to the unprivileged
- Habit of Sharing ايثار
- Your actions not words



Rules for Tarbiya: Moral

9. Forgiveness

- Actions not words...
- Stories
- Provoke and reward

- This is a summary of what my father Shaykh Mufti Muhammad Shafi' concluded in *Ahkam al-Qur'an* (3:193-201).
- “Based on this principle, sports which are intended to exercise the bodies or minds are permissible in themselves, so long as they do not contain other sins, and so long as one is not totally immersed in them to the degree that they infringe on the responsibility of man in his religion and his living. And Allah Most High knows best.”

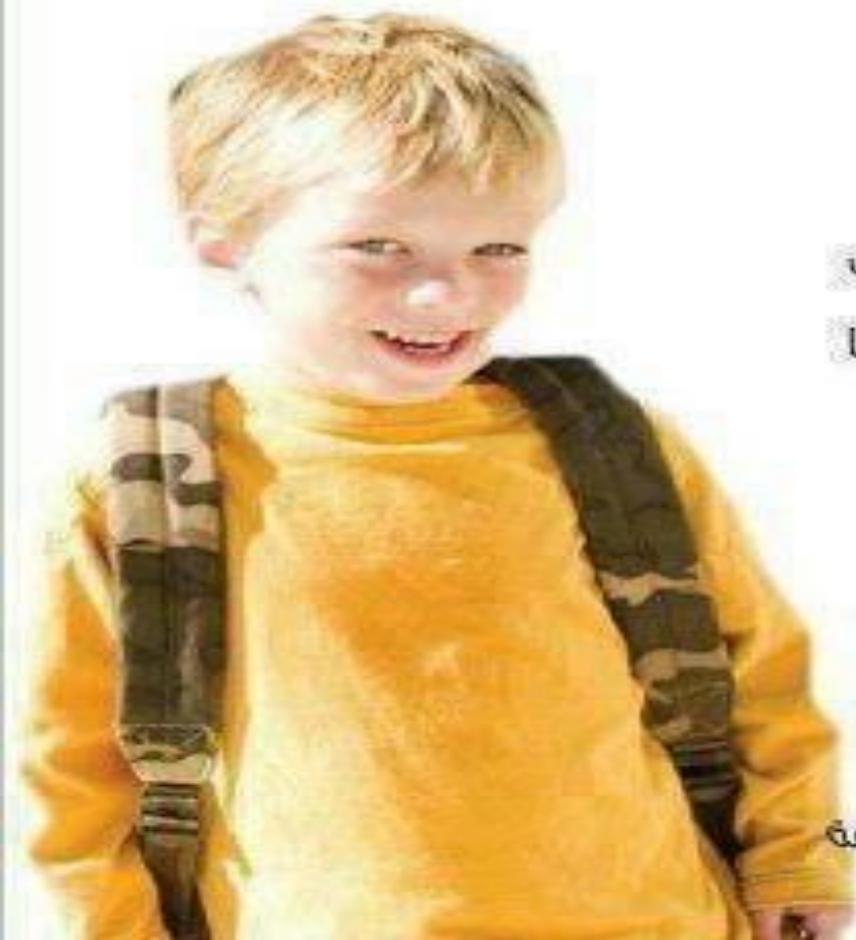
